What should I see?

Jesus saw a great crowd of about 5,000 men coming toward Him. Jesus asked Philip, "Where shall we buy bread for these people to eat?" Philip was doubtful. He didn't think there was any chance of feeding all of the people. Another disciple, Andrew, saw a boy with five small loaves of bread and two fish. He asked Jesus, "How far can this food go?" Andrew was doubtful, too. Jesus then asked His disciples to have all the men sit on the grass. The boy gave his food to Jesus, and Jesus blessed it. They gave thanks and passed the bread and fish to all the men in the crowd. It fed everyone! After they were finished, the disciples gathered twelve more baskets with what was left over.
